

Privacy Policy

In order to be of service to you we process your personal data. Boboli Benelux B.V. highly values your privacy and therefore handles your personal data with utmost care. You can find out more about the way in which we process your data and to which ends we use it in this privacy policy.

Boboli Benelux B.V. has its registered office in Bunschoten-Spakenburg, on Kronkels 16a, 3752LM, the Netherlands. Boboli Benelux B.V. is responsible for the processing of your personal data in the context of the Dutch Personal Data Protection Act / the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

First and foremost, Boboli Benelux B.V. adheres in all cases to the requirements of the data protection law. We handle your data with utmost care, and we will continue to do so, even as we constantly search for the best way for you to make use of our services in the most straightforward and efficient manner.

What data do we process, and what do we use that data for?

We collect your (personal) data and information, which we process for different purposes.

Personal data

We collect your name, email address, phone number, company name and IP address in order to:

- identify you
- provide you with our services

Communication

We use your email address in order to:

- inform you with regard to questions that you have posed through the website www.boboli.nl
- only with your consent: to send out newsletters and other communications. You can always unsubscribe from our newsletter. The newsletter contains a clickable option to unsubscribe.

We collect this data based on your consent.

Boboli Benelux B.V. only processes your personal data based on your consent

Personal data may only be processed if there is legal ground for this (a legal basis). Our legal basis for processing your personal data is your clear consent (article 8, under a, of the Dutch Personal Data Protection Act / article 4, paragraph 11 of the GDPR). By actively agreeing to the terms and conditions, the privacy policy, and the processing of personal data, you give your consent for the processing of your data by Boboli Benelux B.V., as described in this privacy policy.

Self-evidently, you are always allowed to revoke your consent, after which we will delete your personal data from our databases and administration. This right (to revoke your consent) concerns the future processing of your personal data and does not concern the

personal data that has already been processed by us. Without the processing of your data we cannot offer you our services.

Do we share your information with third parties?

Boboli Benelux B.V. does not share your personal data with third parties, unless we have specifically requested your consent to do so, or unless this is required out of legal obligation or due to a judicial ruling.

Adequate level of data protection

We share your data with a few parties inside and outside of Europe in order for our services to properly function. Within Europe, these are Vimexx, for the hosting of our website, Purple Media, for maintaining our website, and T-ICT, for maintaining our mailboxes. These parties possess the adequate level of protection for the processing of any personal data in the context of the Dutch Personal Data Protection Act / the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

Cookies

This website uses cookies. A cookie is a simple and small file that is sent along with the pages of this website and is saved by your browser on your hardware. The information contained therein may be used in a subsequent visit to provide greater ease of access to the website. For example, by loading your personal preferences. If you do not want us to use cookies, you can setup your browser to 'turn cookies off', or you can inquire with your browser provider and request the appropriate settings.

Google Analytics

As part of Google's "Analytics" service, this website places a cookie on your computer of the American company Google. We utilize this service in order to receive reports and keep track of the way visitors use the website. Google may share this information with third parties if Google is legally obliged to do so, or insofar as third parties process this information on behalf of Google. We have no influence over this. We have not given Google our permission to use the acquired analytics information for other Google services. The information collected by Google will be depersonalised as much as possible. Your IP address will explicitly not be handed over. The information is transferred to and saved by Google on servers in the United States. Google states it will adhere to the Privacy Shield principles and is associated with the Privacy Shield programme of the American Trade Department. This ensures there is an adequate level of protection when processing any personal information.

Do we save your personal data?

Yes, Boboli Benelux B.V. saves your data unless you request us to delete your data. Boboli Benelux B.V. deletes your data on request or depersonalises it. Do you want Boboli Benelux B.V. to delete your data? In that case, please send an email to info@boboli.nl. We will either delete your data from our databases and administration or depersonalise it within 14 days.

What are your rights?

Access to your data

As a customer you have the right to access your personal data. This means that you can request what personal data of yours has been registered, and for which purposes this data is used.

Correction on your data

As a customer you have the right to correct your personal data, if it turns out that our registration is no longer valid. This also applies in case the data needs to be supplemented or augmented.

Right to be forgotten

As a customer you have the right to delete your personal data. This means that we can delete your personal data from our systems. Your data can still be processed in a depersonalised or aggregated manner in various management reports.

Right to object

As a customer you have the right to object against the processing of your personal data. We will take your objection, if substantive, into account, and will respond as quickly as possible, and at the very latest within three weeks.

Right to data portability

As a customer you have the right to portability of your personal data. This means that we make your personal data available to you in a standard format, in order for you to reuse it.

Security of data

Boboli Benelux B.V. will take appropriate technical and organisational measures to ensure adequate safeguards for the protection and preservation of the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of your data, with due regard to the state of the art. This also holds true for the information that can be appended, extracted or deducted from this data. Boboli Benelux B.V. will protect both input and output from loss, theft, or any unlawful or unauthorised form of processing.
